Both vessels are 78-foot whale watching catamarans. Our Salish Sea Class Catamarans have a maximum capacity of 96 guests plus 4 crew.

They feature a state-of-the-art drive and propulsion systems with four EPA Tier 3, 700 hp Volvo Penta diesel engines (two in each hull) powering four independent Doen/Thrustmaster Water Jets in the case of the brand new Salish Sea Freedom or Ultra Jets for the Salish Sea Dream.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

On board Salish Sea Dream and Salish Sea Freedom you are a part of a professional marine team who inspires and educates passengers from all over the world! You are working with a team who is outgoing and passionate about sharing their knowledge of our BC coast and its wildlife.

As a 150 Ton Master you are responsible for the safe operation of the vessel, it's crew and passengers. As a leader in the industry you are also responsible for ensuring that both Salish Sea Dream and Salish Sea Freedom are operated in accordance with the industry Whale Watching Guidelines as set out by the PWWA.

As part of the Salish Sea Dream and Salish Sea Freedom teams you are responsible for:

- Operating the vessel in accordance with:
  - Transport Canada Standards,
  - Canada Shipping Act and it's regulations.
- Maintaining vessel logs.
- Conducting crew drills as required.
- Start up and shutdown of the vessel each working day with the assistance of the Chief Mate.
- Ensuring the vessel has sufficient fuel for the start of the next day.
- Working with the shore crews in providing our guests with the best possible experience.
