Job Description & Primary Purpose:

Onboard Ocean Magic and Ocean Magic II, you are a leader of a professional marine team who inspires and educates passengers from all over the world! You will be working with a team who is outgoing and passionate about sharing their knowledge of our BC coast and its wildlife.

As Chief Mate, Limited for a Vessel of Less Than 60 Gross Tonnage, you are a part of the bridge crew. Together with the Master you are responsible for the safe operation of the vessel, it's crew and passengers.

Working with the Master, you will be assisting with:

- Operating the vessel in accordance with:
 - o Transport Canada Standards,
 - o Canada Shipping Act and it's regulations.
 - Maintaining vessel logs.
 - Conducting crew drills as required by Transport Canada and company SOP's.
 - Start up and shutdown of the vessel each working day.
 - Ensuring the vessel is ready for the start of the next day.
 - Working with the shore crews in providing our guests with the best possible experience.
 - Operating in accordance with the Whale Watching Guidelines as set out by the PWWA and the NIMMSA.
 - Assisting in the day to day maintenance of the vessel.
 - Assisting the crew as a Naturalist.

- Up to date and approved Transport Canada Medical examination.
- Working knowledge of the PWWA and NIMMSA Regulations.
- Knowledge of wildlife and the marine environment.

- Ability to work on your feet for up to 12 hours.
- Previous experience in the whale watching industry and knowledge of local marine environments is considered an asset but not required.
- An understanding of electrical and mechanical systems including light marine diesel engines combined with the ability to diagnose, troubleshoot and repair small electrical/mechanical problems on the vessel.
